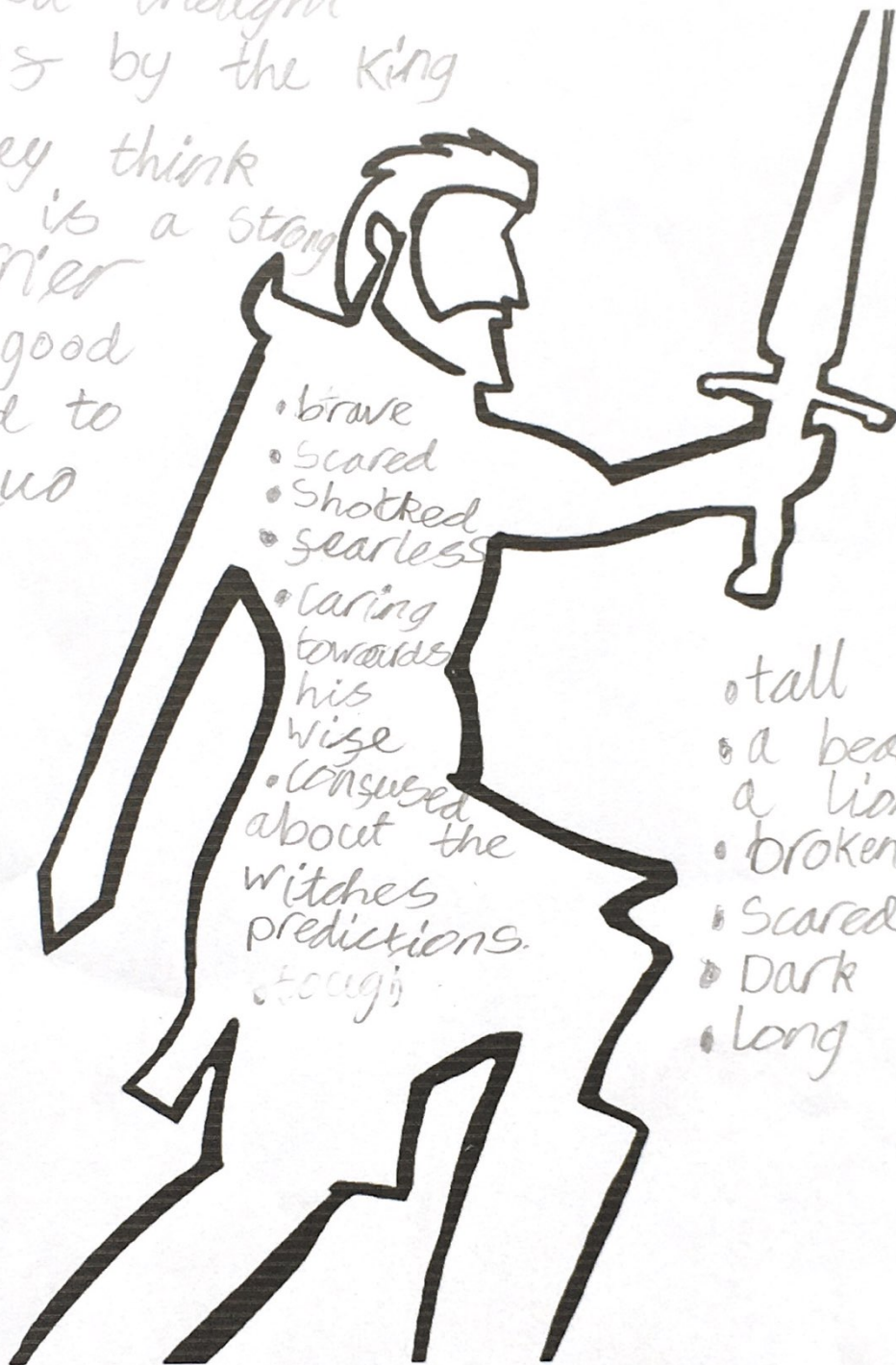


Week 2 - Activity 1

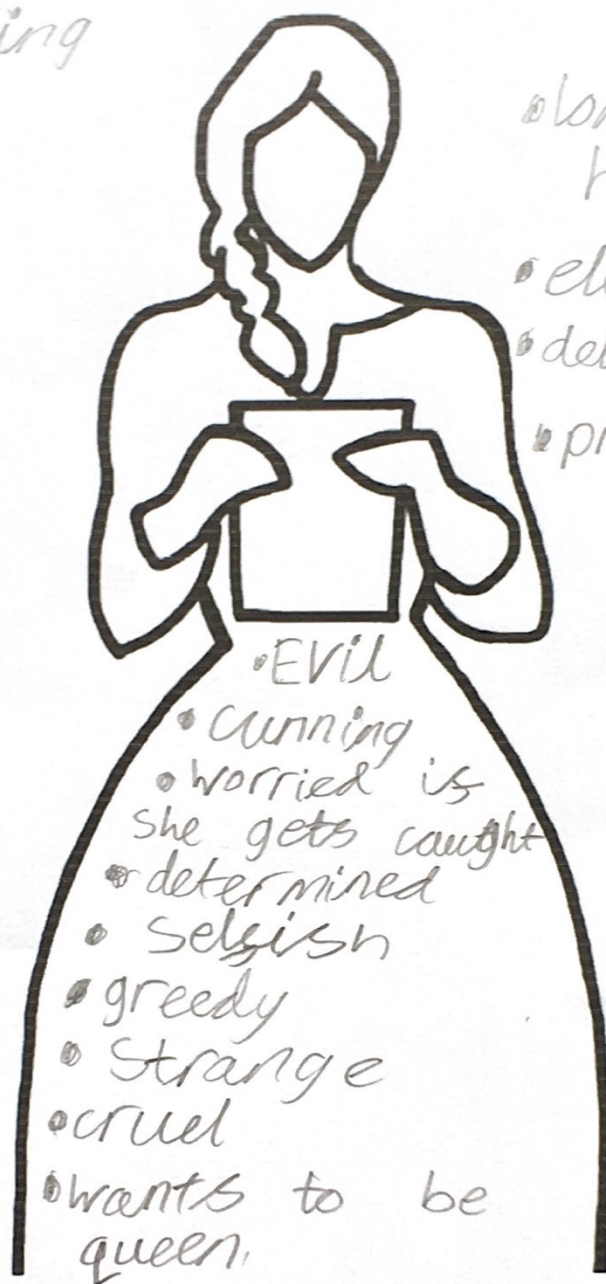
