These activities are for both Reception and Year 1 and are just a few suggestions. Please feel free to adapt or choose them to suit the interests and ability of your child. (*The activities in italics are a little more challenging.*)

<p>Take part in the RSPB Bird Watch and investigate what birds live in your garden! Make bird feeders to attract more birds to your garden. Big Garden Birdwatch The RSPB</p> <p><i>Make a fact file of a bird that you see in your garden.</i></p>	<p>Find out where your favourite fruit comes from. Find the country on a map of the world.</p> <p><i>Write down 3 facts about that country.</i></p>
<p>Draw a map of your route from home to school. Add the features that you pass on your journey.</p> <p><i>What symbols could you use to represent these features?</i></p>	<p>Learn your address and look it up on a map of the local area or Google Earth.</p>
<p><i>Choose a continent to learn about. Make a poster to show all the information you have found out.</i></p>	<p>Explore food packaging in your home. What countries do your foods come from? Can you find these places on a map of the world?</p>
<p>Investigate different types of penguins. Where do penguins live?</p>	<p>Make a list of things you would need to visit a hot place and a cold place in the world.</p>
<p>Science- Materials activity: "Alien Explanation" (see activity sheet on website)</p>	<p>Watch the weather forecast on the television and/ or look at the Met Office weather website. Complete a five day weather report. (see activity sheet on website)</p>
