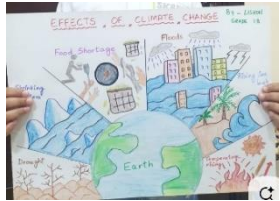


Design an eye-catching poster to be put around the school, to show the effects that climate change is having on our planet.

Create your own climate change wordsearch!

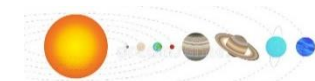
Come up with a fundraiser, that the children of Lea primary school could complete, to raise money for a charity supporting climate change.
