

Using the words -

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Create a poster
campaign to encourage

rainforest. Think about
persuasive language and
what people can do at
home or in other
countries.

Imagine you are going to travel to
the Amazon Rainforest.
You have to research how you are
going to travel to the Amazon
Rainforest, what you would take in
your suitcase with you, what would
you see.
Write it in a diary style could be
past or present style writing.

Create a collage using lots of different materials to
create a scene from a Rainforest. Remember to use
lots of different textures and show off the four
different layers of the rainforest.



Label a world map of rainforest
locations and name as many
rainforests as you can on that
map.



Create a wordsearch
where all the words are
about Rainforests
OR
Create a crossword
where all the answers
are words about
Rainforest

Research any animal that lives in a
rainforest. Find out which layer of
the rainforest it usually lives on, how
does it survive in the rainforest and
are there any adaptations to help
them to survive in the rainforest?

Make a model of your
favourite Amazon
animal using whatever
materials you have
available. Bring it to
school and explain how
you have made it.



Design and make your own flag for the rainforest.
Draw, paint use natural resources (eg. berries,
spices) or even use fabric!
Example is Brazil's national
flag

Rio Carnival Brazilian Cheese Bread



Ingredients

- 170g tapioca flour
- 1 large egg
- 70g grated cheese
- 150ml milk
- 50ml olive oil, plus extra for greasing the muffin tin
- 1tsp salt

Optional

- Crushed garlic clove
- Mixed herbs

Equipment

- Mini muffin tins
- Pastry brush
- Blender
- Cooling rack

Method

1. Preheat the oven to 220°C, gas mark 7.
2. Brush a little oil around the insides of the muffin tin wells.
3. Put all the ingredients in a blender and mix until smooth. Use the pulse feature to blend slowly.
4. Pour the batter into the muffin tin about 2/3 full.
5. Bake in the oven for about 15-20 minutes, until golden brown.
6. Remove from the oven and allow to cool slightly before removing each bread from the muffin tin.
7. Serve warm.



Alternatives to Try:

- Use corn flour instead of tapioca flour.
- If you are using a larger muffin tin, your breads will need longer to bake.
